



TOURNAMENT RULES

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

Eight teams are divided into two groups of four teams. Group stage consists of 3 games per team. Top two teams from each group advance to semi-finals. Bottom two teams from each group will play a consolation game, bringing the minimum number of games per team to four. Losers of the semi-final advance to a 3rd place game. Winners of the semi-final games advance to the final. Trophies are given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. All participants will receive a medal.

- Games will be played at Ed Bush Stadium (astroturf) and Truman Bodden Sports Complex (grass). Training sessions will be available on grass.
- Water and Gatorade will be available at all matches
- Closing ceremonies and medal ceremony

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- Participating players must be born June 1, 2001 or after (3 players born Jan 1, 2001 or later are allowed)
- Each team may roster 20 players per game
- Substitutions – Unlimited substitutions are allowed, substituted players cannot return to play.
- Duration of the matches – 2 x 35 minutes halves for regular time, 10minute half-time break.
- Group stage regular time winners will be awarded 3 points, draws will be awarded 1 point and nil to the loser.
- Group stage positioning criteria – Teams will be ranked based on the following criteria:
 - Total number of points;
 - Goal difference in all group matches;
 - Goals scored in all group matches;
 - Less red cards received;
 - Less yellow cards received;
 - Drawing to be organized by the tournament organizing committee.
- Play Off (semi-final, final and 3rd place) matches untie procedures – If a match is tied after the regular time:
 - Extra time of 2 x 10 minutes halves will be played; then
 - Penalty shoot-out to determine the winner.
- All other FIFA Laws of the Game and regulations apply.
